



Collegian of the Year

Rouse Hill Anglican College is focussed on providing a learning environment that is underpinned by a Christian ethos, offering excellence in education and the development of individual potential within a caring and dynamic environment. In 2007, the College conducted the first of a series of overseas mission service trips and in subsequent years we have seen the extensive development of a range of service programs which place our focus on the needs of other people in our world. It is our prayer and hope that students take the skills and values learnt through their formal education into their future endeavours.

In 2012, the Parents and Friends Association introduced a "Collegian of the Year" Award to recognise and support the work of a former student who is building upon the values and skills learnt whilst at Rouse Hill Anglican College to actively contribute to serving the wider community.

The successful recipient will be recognised at the annual Presentation Night in December and will be added to an Honour Board. The Parents and Friends Association will also make a donation of \$2000 to a non-profit organisation chosen by the Collegian of the Year.

Eligibility Criteria

- Nominees must have completed Year Twelve at Rouse Hill Anglican College
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years
- Self-nominations will be accepted or can be nominated by another person

Selection Criteria

Nominees will be judged on:

- Significant contribution to the wider community (locally, nationally or globally)
- Achievements as an individual or as part of a group or organisation
- Voluntary work beyond paid employment
- A role model within the wider community
- Leadership skills

How does the Award Process Work?

- Graduates of the College are invited to either apply for themselves or nominate someone who is actively contributing to the wider community
- Nominations are short-listed by the selection panel, who may choose to conduct interviews
- Recipient is notified and invited to attend the Presentation Night to be recognised as Collegian of the Year.
