The College would be willing to provide financial assistance to complete a teacher training course after the successful applicant is employed.

The successful applicant will be a committed Christian with a strong understanding of the Bible and a personal commitment to doctrine and theology that is consistent with the teachings of the Anglican Church, Diocese of Sydney.

### **Applications should include:**

- The RHAC teacher application form (available on the school website in the employment section).
- A cover letter and curriculum vitae.
- The names and contact details of three referees, including a professional referee and preferably a referee who can attest to the Christian beliefs and practices of the applicant. Applicants who would prefer not to provide their referee's details when they apply will be asked to provide that information if they are offered a first-round interview.
- A current WWCC number and NESAs teacher accreditation number. Applicants who do not have either or both of these numbers by the time they apply should explain this in a cover letter.
- A certified copy of a testamur of applicable academic qualifications.
- Official evidence that the applicant has been vaccinated for Covid-19 or a statement in their cover letter that they have not received the Covid-19 vaccine.

Applications close on ***Monday 1 May 2023***.

Potential applicants are very welcome to contact the College to have an informal, confidential conversation with the Head of Senior School about the role before they formally apply.
