The College is open to offering a permanent contract to the preferred applicant, although we are also willing to offer a temporary contract if that is what the successful applicant would prefer. Christians who are actively involved in a church are particularly encouraged to apply.

- The RHAC application form (available on the school website in the employment section).

- The names and contact details of two referees, including a professional referee and preferably a referee who can attest to the Christian beliefs and practices of the applicant.
- A current WWCC number and NESA teacher accreditation number.
- A certified copy of a testamur of applicable academic qualifications.
- Official evidence that the applicant has been double vaccinated for Covid-19, or a statement in the cover letter that the candidate is unvaccinated.
